
Here's everything you need to know to make the years first race unforgettable

You've arrived at the first stop of the 2015 - 2016 Ice Cross Downhill Championship Tour. Quebec City, is one of the most iconic races on the entire Red Bull Crashed Ice Circuit, we will take the City by storm on November 27- 28 2015. Here, the top ice cross downhill athletes from around the globe will storm down an enormous urban ice track riddled with masive drops, steps, hairpin turns and big-air jumps in front of thousands of screaming fans.

Red Bull Crashed Ice has touched down in over 11 countries around the world since the circuit kick off in 2001, drawing more than 350,000 spectators around the world last year alone. Quebec City is a classic stop on the tour – it is the capital city of the province of Quebec, which is located within the Capitale-National region an is the second most populous City in Quebec, after Montreal. This year is especially one to remember as it marks the 10th edition! Quebec City 2015 Ice Cross Downhill stop promises to deliver one the best races yet.

THE COURSE

This years Quebec City course will find itself once again back in the 2014 location starting from Hotel du Parlement and finishing in Place D'Youville. Stretching 460m from top to bottom and averaging a width of 15 feet, it will be one of the longest tracks of the 2015- 2016 series.




